

International Fellowship of Christian Short-term Mission (IFSTM)

IFSTM was established during the period of the 4th CCOWE conference in July 1991, and was registered in U.S.A. as a Chinese International Missionary Organization in December 1994. Further, it was registered in Hong Kong in Dec, 2012 too. We coordinate overseas mission work among the seven STM training centres : Hong Kong, Toronto, Miri of Malaysia, Vancouver, New York, Sydney and Thailand. Our goal is to enable Chinese churches to fulfill the everybody-involved in 'Short-term Mission Movement', so the Gospel will be rapidly spread over the world.

Effect of Mission and Direction for Development

- Coordinating :
 - Through partnership, contact among STM centres are maintained;
 - Through IFSTM newsletters, each are encouraged, prayed for and remembered.
- Communicating :
 - Exchange of course designs and teaching materials;
 - Making use of resources for outreach methods and equipment;
 - Lecturers, co-workers and STM students sharing among themselves to facilitate STM practices.
 - Sharing overall experience in IFSTM conference held once every 5 years.
- Supporting :
 - Calling upon STM centres and member to help any STM centre in need of manpower, finances or materials;
 - Calling upon STM centres and member to support places without STM centres, with gospel outreach and STM training plans.
- Sending out :

STM teams, non-local short term missionaries or long term missionaries for 3 months to 2 years will be sent out to Chinese communities overseas. They will do mission work, helping communities either to set up local STM training courses or centres, so as to enable national Chinese Christians to gradually do Gospel outreach and to plant churches themselves.
- Cooperating :

To communicate with Chinese churches from different parts of the world and existing Chinese mission organizations established in the districts, so as to explore the most effective ways of working together,

We believe that short-term missionaries are the human resources of long-term missionaries, and global Chinese gospel outreach is the spring board of cross cultural mission work.

We are thankful to the Lord that from 1993 to 2014, IFSTM has sent out 115 mission teams (total 968 man-time for 1,701 days) to 40 mission fields (Toronto, New York, Sydney, South Africa, Uganda, Israel, C Nation in Euro-Asia, Romania, Western Europe, Holland, Central and South America, Kyrgyz, Malaysia, Vietnam, Cambodia, Myanmar, Taiwan and Macau etc.), working with the local churches or the Chinese missionaries. May God be glorified !

The meaning and value of short term mission has been confirmed by the Bible. The Lord who set up the town and village mission team of the 70, apart from the 12 apostles, is the best example. It is even better to have experienced being a short term missionary and then be inspired to become a long term missionary. In fact, it is closed to 90% long term missionaries in North America, coming from short term mission learning. IFSTM is at present making great effort to encourage over 500 past STM students of two-year trained, over 100 past students of 6 months trained and over 600 past students of one-month trained from all STM centres, to consider taking part in the overseas short term mission work ranged from 3 months to 2 years, so as to support the work of the front-line mission work, hoping that one day there will be more long term missionaries who will commit their lives to enlarge God's Kingdom.
